Campaign Volunteer and Staff COVID Policy

March 18, 2021

The health and safety of Alexandrians during this campaign is my top priority. In order to maintain safety of our staff, volunteers, and the community, my campaign has adopted the following policies per Virginia and CDC guidance. Everyone associated with this campaign, including staff and volunteers, must adhere to these policies while participating in all campaign activities:

- Face coverings/masks must be worn properly at all times. We are encouraging double masking or the use of N95 masks
- Physical distance of six feet or more must be maintained at all times.
- Volunteers must complete a health questionnaire before engaging in campaign activities attesting that they are not currently experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and have not been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19.
- Anyone experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 (including but not limited to: fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste and smell) may not participate in campaign activities.
- To safely connect with voters, all affiliates of the campaign - including volunteers - will be trained to keep social distance during all conversations and door-to-door activities, conduct contactless delivery of campaign literature, maintain safety precautions at all times, etc.
- Volunteers will always have the option to conduct contactless activities if they are not comfortable interacting with others.
